



I INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF LEGAL SCIENCES

Art. 1º. The Impacto Científico Publishing House, headquartered in the city of São José dos Pinhais, located at: Antonina, 957 – Cidade Jardim, ZIP Code: 83035-350, registered under CNPJ nº 55.783.061/0001-64.

The Impacto Científico Publishing House, through its organizer Giovana Máximo Chandocha, informs that as of February 1, 2025, registrations are open for the I International Congress of Legal Sciences, which will take place on May 20, 2025. The participation rules are defined in this regulation.

§1º. The I International Congress of Legal Sciences aims to promote and encourage academic production and critical analysis of multidisciplinary topics. Additionally, it seeks to disseminate best practices and outstanding works, fostering scientific debate and providing opportunities for interaction between the academic community and business and governmental sectors related to the legal field.

§2º. This event will be valid at both national and international levels, and students, professors, researchers, the academic community, entrepreneurs, consultants, professionals, and others interested in the legal field may participate.

§3º. The evaluation committee of the I International Congress of Legal Sciences will be composed of professionals in the field, freely designated by the event's organizing committee.

§4º. The evaluators, members of the examining committee, may not have a kinship relationship up to the second degree, whether by consanguinity, adoption, or affinity, with the authors of the papers they evaluate, prioritizing impartiality in decisions.

PARTICIPANTS

Art. 2º. The congress is aimed at students enrolled in any undergraduate, postgraduate, master's, or doctoral level, as well as those who have completed their studies from the first year or first semester of any course in an institution, provided they are duly enrolled or graduated and register for the I International Congress of Legal Sciences.

REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION

Art. 3º. The presentation must be made by at least one of the authors, including the names of the other co-authors of the paper. Co-authorship of up to 10 (ten) participants is allowed, provided they meet the requirements established in Art. 2º of this regulation.

§1º. Participants are free to choose their topic within the field of Law.



§2º. Any paper that does not refer to research results or does not present the data on which the participant based their study, as well as any paper submitted outside the deadline established in this regulation, will be disqualified.

§3º. Papers with authorship violations or any other legal infringement will be disqualified.

SUBMISSION OF PAPERS

Art. 3º. Papers must be submitted by 11:59 PM on 05/18/2025.

Art. 4º. Submission of papers is free, as they will initially be evaluated. The formal acceptance letter will only be sent after approval to begin the payment process.

§1º. Corrections will be made continuously, as well as presentations. After the review, we will contact the participants via email:

§2º. To participate as a listener, it is only necessary to complete the form on the website, and we will confirm the registration by email.

§3º. The registration fee for listeners is R\$ 30,00 (thirty reais).

§4º. Participation with paper presentation requires a fee of R\$ 167,00 (one hundred and sixty-seven reais) per paper formally accepted by email.

REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMISSION

Art. 5º. Papers must meet the following length requirements:

Article: minimum 8 and maximum 35 pages.

Clinical study: minimum 4 and maximum 20 pages.

Extended abstract: minimum 1 and maximum 4 pages.

Simple abstract: minimum 1 and maximum 2 pages.

Case report: minimum 2 and maximum 8 pages.

Presentation model: minimum 2 and maximum 10 pages.

Poster: minimum 1 and maximum 4 pages.

All documents must be submitted in Word format through the event website form.

EVALUATION

Art. 8º. The examining committee will evaluate all papers based on the following criteria:

- a) Grammatical accuracy;
- b) Structural completeness;
- c) Appropriate language;



- d) Research source approach strategy;
- e) Justification and argumentation;
- f) Persuasiveness.

PRESENTATIONS

Art. 10°. Pre-recorded presentation:

The video must be recorded in horizontal format.

It must be between 7 and 10 minutes.

Using PowerPoint is recommended to facilitate viewing of the presenter along with the slides.

The video must be sent as a YouTube link through the Impacto Científico website after registration payment.

The presentation must include the paper title and the responsible author's email.

Art. 11°. Live presentation:

It will be held via Google Meet on the event day.

Presenters must be online at the assigned time.

Art. 12°. Publication without presentation:

In this modality, the paper only needs to be submitted in writing, following the congress standards.

FINAL PROVISIONS

Art. 13°. Participation in this event does not grant participants any right or advantage that is not expressly provided for in this regulation.

Art. 14°. Participants will receive attendance certificates (listeners) and/or paper presentation certificates.

The congress proceedings will be published with CrossRef/DOI registration and certification of oral presentation of scientific papers.

Art. 15°. Participants declare and implicitly accept that they are the authors or co-authors of the submitted papers, assuming legal responsibility and exempting Impacto Científico Publishing House and the organizers from any liability.

Art. 16°. Participants authorize the use of their name and image for event promotion.

Art. 17°. This event and its regulation may be modified or canceled due to force majeure.

Art. 18°. Any issue not covered in this regulation will be resolved by the organizing committee.
