



II International Multidisciplinary Congress

Art. 1. Impacto Científico Publishing, headquartered in the city of São José dos Pinhais, located at Antonina, 957 – Cidade Jardim, ZIP code: 83035-350, registered with CNPJ under no. 55.783.061/0001-64.

Impacto Científico Publishing, through its organizer Giovana Máximo Chandocha, informs that registrations for the II International Multidisciplinary Congress are open, starting from February 1, 2025, and the event will take place on June 17, 2025. The participation rules are defined by this notice.

§1. The II International Multidisciplinary Congress aims to promote and encourage academic production and critical analysis of multidisciplinary themes. It also seeks to disseminate good practices and quality works, fostering scientific discussion and providing opportunities for interaction between the academic community and the business and government sectors.

§2. This event will be valid throughout the national and international territory, allowing participation from undergraduate students, professors, researchers, the academic community, entrepreneurs, consultants, professionals, and other interested parties.

§3. The examining committee of the II International Multidisciplinary Congress will be composed of professionals from the respective fields, freely appointed by the event's organizing committee.

§4. The evaluators, members of the examining committee, cannot have kinship up to the second degree, by blood, adoption, or affinity, with the authors whose work they are evaluating, with impartiality being prioritized in the decisions.

PARTICIPANTS

Art. 2. The congress is open to students enrolled in any level of undergraduate, postgraduate, master's, or doctoral programs, as well as those who have completed the course from the 1st year or 1st semester of any course at an institution, provided they are regularly enrolled or graduated and register for the II International Multidisciplinary Congress.

REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION

Art. 3. Submission must be made by at least one of the authors to submit the paper, including the names of the other co-authors, with co-authorship allowed for up to 10 (ten) participants, provided that the participants meet the requirements of Art. 2 of this notice.

§1. The theme will be freely chosen by the participants.

- All academic axes.



§2. The paper will be disqualified if it does not reference the research results or fail to indicate the data from the research that the participant based their work on, as well as if it is submitted after the deadline established in this notice.

§3. The paper will be disqualified if it has authorship flaws or any other illegalities.

SUBMISSION

Art. 3. Papers must be submitted by 11:59 PM on June 15, 2025.

Art. 4. All submissions are free of charge, as they will first be submitted for evaluation, and the formal acceptance letter will be sent only after approval, to begin the payment process.

§1. The review process is continuous, as is the submission process. After the evaluation, we will contact the participant via email at congresso@sevenevents.com.br or faleconosco@impactocientifico.com.

§2. To participate as an attendee, simply fill out the form on the website, and we will confirm the registration via email.

§3. The registration fee for participants as attendees is R\$ 30.00 (thirty reais).

§4. To participate with paper submission and possible presentation, the participation fee will be R\$ 167.00 (one hundred sixty-seven reais) per paper for which the author receives formal acceptance via email.

RULES FOR SUBMISSION

Art. 5. The full paper must contain a minimum of 8 (eight) and a maximum of 35 (thirty-five) pages. The clinical study must contain a minimum of 4 (four) and a maximum of 20 (twenty) pages. The extended abstract must contain a minimum of 1 (one) and a maximum of 4 (four) pages. The simple abstract must contain a minimum of 1 (one) and a maximum of 2 (two) pages. The case report must contain a minimum of 2 (two) and a maximum of 8 (eight) pages. The exposition model must contain a minimum of 2 (two) and a maximum of 10 (ten) pages. The poster must contain a minimum of 1 (one) and a maximum of 4 (four) pages. All models must be submitted in Word format via the event's website.

Art. 6. Each paper may have a maximum of 10 (ten) authors and must not exceed 35 (thirty-five) pages.

§1. The paper must be submitted in Word format with Times New Roman font, size 12, following ABNT standards.

Art. 7. There is no limit on the number of submissions per author.



EVALUATION CRITERIA

Art. 8. The examining committee defined in Art. 1, §3 of this notice will evaluate all papers.

Art. 9. The evaluation criteria for the papers will be:

- a) grammatical correctness;
- b) appropriateness of format;
- c) appropriate language;
- d) research source approach strategy;
- e) grounding and rhetoric;
- f) persuasiveness.

PRESENTATIONS

Art. 10. Recorded - The video must be recorded in landscape format (i.e., if using a mobile phone to record, the phone should be placed horizontally).

The total duration must be at least 7 (seven) minutes and no more than 10 (ten) minutes.

If using image tools for the presentation, we suggest using PowerPoint for the recording, as it facilitates simultaneous viewing of the speaker and the slides.

Once recorded, the video must be submitted through the Impacto website, on the page designated for video submissions, as a YouTube link AFTER PAYMENT IS MADE.

The submission must include the paper's title and the corresponding author's email.

Art. 11. Live - The presentation will occur on the event day through the Google Meet platform, and the presenter must be online at the time of their presentation. To check the best available time, please wait for the email containing the guidelines for the schedule.

Art. 12. Publication Only - In this modality, there is no need for a presentation; simply submit the paper in writing according to the congress model, and we will follow the same process as for other papers.

FINAL PROVISIONS

Art. 13. Participation in this event will not grant participants any other rights or benefits other than those explicitly provided in these regulations.

Art. 14. Participants will receive certificates of participation (attendees) and/or paper presentation. The congress proceedings will be published and will receive CrossRef/DOI registrations and certification of oral paper presentation at a scientific congress.

Art. 15. Participants declare and tacitly accept that they are the authors or co-authors of the works and are responsible for them, exempting Impacto Científico Publishing, partners, and organizers from any civil, criminal, copyright, or other responsibilities that may arise from irregularities caused by the participants.



Art. 16. Participants agree to all the rules established in these regulations and authorize the use of their name and image in any communication vehicles or tools for the purposes of promoting this event.

Art. 17. This event, as well as its regulations, may be modified, suspended, or canceled with notice, for reasons of force majeure or any other unforeseen factor or circumstance beyond the control of Impacto Científico Publishing, which may affect the regular conduct of the promotion and substantially alter or prevent its original plan.

Art. 18. Other matters not provided for in this notice will be decided by the event's organizing committee. Furthermore, the decisions will be final, irrevocable, and non-appealable. The mere participation in this event implies complete knowledge and unconditional acceptance of these regulations.
