Art. 1. Impacto Científico Publishing, headquartered in the city of São José dos Pinhais, at the address: Antonina, 957 – Cidade Jardim, ZIP code: 83035-350, registered under CNPJ No. 55.783.061/0001-64.

Impacto Científico Publishing, through its organizer Giovana Máximo Chandocha, announces that registrations are open starting on February 1, 2025, for the 1st International Congress on Biological and Agricultural Sciences, which will take place on March 25, 2025. The participation rules are defined by this notice.

§1. The 1st International Congress on Biological and Agricultural Sciences aims to promote and encourage academic production and critical analysis of multidisciplinary topics. It also seeks to disseminate good practices and quality work, fostering scientific discussions and providing opportunities for interaction between the academic community and the business and government sectors related to the field of Biological and Agricultural Sciences.

§2. This event is open to participants from both national and international territories, including undergraduate students, professors, researchers, the academic community, businesspeople, consultants, professionals, and others interested in the field of Biological and Agricultural Sciences.

§3. The examining committee for the 1st International Congress on Biological and Agricultural Sciences will consist of professionals in the relevant fields, appointed at the discretion of the event's organizing committee.

§4. Evaluators, members of the examining committee, may not have any familial relationships up to the second degree, either by blood, adoption, or affinity, with the authors whose work they evaluate, prioritizing impartiality in decision-making.

PARTICIPANTS

Art. 2. Participation in the congress is open to students enrolled at any level of undergraduate, graduate, master's, or doctoral programs, as well as those who have completed their courses since the 1st year or semester of any program at an institution, provided they are regularly enrolled or have graduated and register for the 1st International Congress on Biological and Agricultural Sciences.

REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION

Art. 3. Submission must be made by at least one (1) of the authors to submit the paper, including the names of the other co-authors. Co-authorship of up to ten (10) participants is allowed, provided that all members meet the requirements outlined in Art. 2 of this notice.

§1. The topic is freely chosen by the participants.

- General Biology, Genetics, Botany, Zoology, Ecology, Morphology, Physiology, Biochemistry, Biophysics, Pharmacology, Immunology, Microbiology, Parasitology, Agronomy, Forestry Resources and Forest Engineering, Agricultural Engineering, Animal Science, Veterinary Medicine, Fisheries Resources and Fishery Engineering, Food Science and Technology.



§2. Articles that do not refer to research results or fail to point out the data of the research upon which the participant based their work will be disqualified, as well as those submitted after the deadline specified in this notice.

§3. Articles with authorship violations or any other illegalities will be disqualified.

SUBMISSION

Art. 3. Articles must be submitted by 23:59 on March 24, 2025.

Art. 4. All work submissions are free of charge, as they will initially be reviewed. The formal acceptance letter will only be sent after approval, to initiate the payment process.

§1. Corrections are made on a continuous flow, as is the submission. After the review, we will contact the participant via the email address congresso@sevenevents.com.br or faleconosco@impactocientifico.com.

§2. To participate as an observer, simply fill out the form on the website, and we will confirm the registration by email.

§3. The participation fee for observers is R\$ 30.00 (Thirty reais).

§4. For participation with work submission and possible presentation, the participation fee is R\$ 167.00 (One hundred sixty-seven reais) per work for which the author receives formal acceptance via email.

RULES FOR SUBMISSION

Art. 5. The complete article must contain at least 8 (eight) and no more than 35 (thirty-five) pages. Clinical studies must contain at least 4 (four) and no more than 20 (twenty) pages. The expanded abstract must contain at least 1 (one) and no more than 4 (four) pages. The simple abstract must contain at least 1 (one) and no more than 2 (two) pages. Case reports must contain at least 2 (two) and no more than 8 (eight) pages. The presentation model must contain at least 2 (two) and no more than 10 (ten) pages. The poster must contain at least 1 (one) and no more than 4 (four) pages. All models must be submitted in Word format through the event website.

Art. 6. Each paper may have no more than 10 (ten) authors and cannot exceed 35 (thirty-five) pages.

§1. The article must be submitted in Word format using the Times New Roman font, size 12, following ABNT standards.

Art. 7. There is no limit on the number of submissions per author.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Art. 8. The examining committee, as specified in Art. 1, §3, will evaluate all articles.

Art. 9. The evaluation criteria for the articles will be:

- a) grammatical correctness;
- b) formal appropriateness;
- c) proper language;
- d) research source approach strategy;



- e) foundation and rhetoric;
- f) persuasion.

PRESENTATIONS

Art. 10. Recorded - The video must be filmed in landscape format (i.e., if using a mobile phone, the device should be placed horizontally);

The total duration must be at least 7 (seven) minutes and no more than 10 (ten) minutes;

If using visual aids for the presentation, we suggest using PowerPoint as it facilitates the simultaneous view of the speaker and the slides;

Once recorded, the video must be submitted through the Impacto website, on the video submission page, as a YouTube link AFTER payment is completed;

The submission should include the work's title and the corresponding author's email.

Art. 11. Live - The presentation will take place on the event day via Google Meet. The presenter must be online at the time of their presentation. For scheduling details, please wait for the email with instructions.

Art. 12. Publication-only - This option does not require a presentation. Simply submit the paper according to the congress model, and we will follow the same process as for other submissions.

FINAL PROVISIONS

Art. 13. Participation in this event does not entitle participants to any rights or benefits not expressly provided in this regulation.

Art. 14. Participants will receive certificates of participation (observers) and/or presentation certificates. The congress proceedings will be published and receive CrossRef/DOI records and certification for oral presentation of scientific work at the congress.

Art. 15. Participants declare and tacitly accept that they are the authors or co-authors of the works, assuming responsibility for them and exempting Impacto Científico Publishing, its partners, and organizers from any civil, criminal, copyright, or other liabilities arising from participant irregularities.

Art. 16. Participants agree to all rules set forth in this regulation and authorize the use of their name and image for publicity purposes related to this event.

Art. 17. This event, along with its regulation, may be changed, suspended, or canceled due to force majeure or any other unforeseen factor beyond the control of Impacto Científico Publishing that would prevent or substantially alter the event's execution.

Art. 18. Any issues not addressed in this notice will be decided by the event's organizing committee. All decisions will be final, irrevocable, and non-appealable. Simply participating in this event implies full knowledge and unrestricted acceptance of this regulation.
